As children will sometimes be participating in messy activities such as painting or clay work, an overall is essential. An old tee shirt is adequate for these purposes.

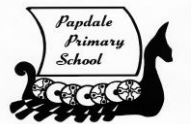
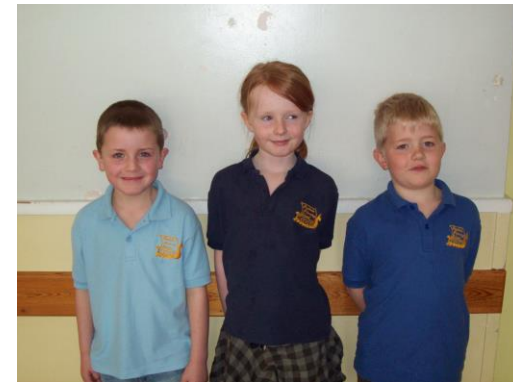
Labels
